Perceptions	Had you heard about eye donation before we talked to you about this study?  Could you tell me a bit about what you know about eye donation?	How did you hear about eye donation? Do you, or anyone you know, have a donor card?  Were you surprised to learn that people with conditions such as cancer can donate?
Preference	Could you share your thoughts about how you feel about donation generally?  What are your feelings and thoughts about eye donation?  Is donation something that your family would support? Should your family be able to make a decision on your behalf?	Would you consider donation if it was possible? Would you consider eye donation? Is this an important issue for you?  <b>If not supportive of donation</b> – could you tell us about why this is not something that you would consider?
