

Health State Preference Project Survey - Further Information

What will happen to me if I take part?

If you take part in the survey you will be presented with a choice of imaginary health states and asked to choose which health state you would prefer to live in. The health states will ask about a range of different health areas (e.g. slight pain) and you will be asked to imagine living in this health state for a certain number of years before dying. You may also be asked to imagine someone else living in a health state for a certain number of years before dying. The survey will also include questions about your general health.

Will my taking part in this project be kept confidential?

All information which is collected about you during the course of the research will be kept strictly confidential. The information you give will not be used in any way that could identify you.
